



## Vaccine Passports:



From 17th May international travel will be permitted to a limited number of countries and in some cases proof of Covid-19 vaccination will be required. The mechanism for proving your vaccine status is through the NHS app. For those who cannot access the NHS app you can request written proof that you have received your Covid-19 vaccinations by telephoning the NHS on 119.

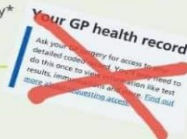
### COVID VACCINE STATUS

The app can be downloaded now from the Apple and Google app stores, alternatively a paper version will be available by calling 119

Your covid vaccine status will be viewable automatically\*  
**There is no need request your full health record, and no need to contact the surgery**

You are welcome to request your full health record, please be aware that it takes around 30 minutes to review one record which takes GPs away from care when we are already extremely busy
